Faculty and scholars are accessing Web of Science and Scopus through their institutional email IDs provided by the university.

The laboratories of different departments are being made state-of-the-art to make them contemporary, subsequently this will help in improving the quality and making them of international standard. These efforts are to make research of the university contemporary and futuristic. Addition of a state-of-the-art Conference Hall for IQAC and efforts to restore the National Knowledge Network in the all the libraries of the university (including e-Learning Centre of the Central Library of the university)

Health and hygiene are another area of concern at the institutes of higher education as the students especially the research scholars and their supervisors (faculty) stay for a longer period in the campus. Hence, setting up of a referral dispensary for immediate medical assistance to the students and faculty members of the university in the Basic and Applied Science building is an effort that is highly appreciable. Although, each department is having their own Sick Room and First Aid facilities. Multi-Gym in the basement and good canteen of the university has made the campus vibrant and making the students and faculty members enjoyable within the campus.

Sports facilities of the university is limited due to space crunch. But indoor stadium and indoor games facilities overcome these limitations. The students at the university utilize the facilities of Birsa Munda stadium and its sports facilities at Morabadi which is easily accessible to them. Here they practice and excel in their sports of interest.

Tribal and Regional Languages comprising of nine Dr. Binod Kumar Mahto departments coupled with Department of Fine Arts (an independent Vocational self-financing programme of the university)has given a platform and has Dr. Sameer Gunjan Lakra institutionalized which facilitate and promotes the culture and languages of the Jharkhand.
